The series is open to all current road race license holders, and paid up 2009 members of NG Road Racing Club

- 2009 250GP ACU National Championship - open to riders with a National or International license on 1st March 2009
- 250GP NG Cup - open to riders with a Clubman license or below on 1st March 2009 (Except for previous 250GP NG Cup Champions who are only eligible for the National Championship)

Flags - Blue flags will be used for this series. All other flags will be used in accordance with the current ACU handbook

Tyres - Any tyres are permitted as per the current ACU handbook

Testing - There are no restrictions on testing at any venue (available by booking direct with the venue except 14th August at Anglesey which is booked via the Club)

Fuel - As per the current ACU handbook

Champions - The winner of the National Championship shall be crowned -

The 2009 250GP ACU National Champion

The winner of the NG Cup shall be crowned -

The 2009 250GP NG Cup Champion

One day event format - One free practice (possibly mixed with other classes)
One qualifying session for 20 minutes
One race minimum of 20 miles

Two day event format - Day 1 - One free practice (possibly mixed with other classes)
1 x qualifying session for 25 minutes
1 x Championship race approx 20 miles

Two day event format - Day 2 - 1 x 10 minute untimed warm up
1 x Championship race approx 30 miles

Donington Park format - TBC

Cost – Registration/club membership fee of £20.00 is payable to NG Road Racing Club.

Regulations and entry forms for all events will be sent to all registered riders automatically as soon as available and must be completed in full and submitted prior to the stated closing date

Entries are £150.00 for each event. (Donington Park £200) There will be no extra charge for the second day of 2 day events.

NB - all registered competitors are welcome to enter the Phoenix Open Club Championship races, which also includes timed qualifying, and the NG Up to 400cc 2 stroke Class. Fees will be at the second ride rate.

Prizes - Points for both classes will be awarded as follows 25 - 1st 20, 16, 13, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 - 15th
Prize money: National Championship 1st £100 2nd £75 3rd £50 4th £25- NG Cup 1st £60 2nd £40 3rd £25

A trophy and bottle of Champagne will be awarded to the first 3 finishers in both Championships at a podium ceremony / photo shoot, which will take place immediately after each race.

Dunlop Motorsport will provide free tyres to the series which will be presented as Performance of the Day awards.

Sponsors – Championship Sponsor stickers must be clearly displayed at all times as instructed.

Championship points may be deducted if such stickers are not clearly visible.
