



NG 2012 CLASS INFORMATION

CLASS	DESCRIPTION
250cc Fourstrokes	Open to all 250 Fourstroke Machines
125cc GP	All GP based machines up to 125cc. Slick tyres permitted.
Formula 125	All production based machines up to 125cc (inc 80cc GP). Any moulded treaded tyre, no slicks.
400cc Streetstocks	Solo machines up to 400cc as per series rules. Any moulded treaded tyre, no slicks.
A & R Formula 400	Production based 250cc two-stroke and 400cc four-stroke as per ACU Handbook. Any moulded treaded tyre, no slicks.
Gofasterbits.co.uk 450cc Open	Solo machines up to 450cc (excluding F125). Slick tyres permitted.
Pirelli UK GP45	Solo, four stroke machines in two classes, single and twin cylinder. 450cc only. Singles - Any Pirelli tyre may be used sourced via Dennis Trollope Racing Spares or A&R Racing Services. Twins – no tyre restrictions. No tyre restriction on wet or rain.
Pro-Bolt 600cc Open	Solo machines 401 - 600cc 4 cylinder (including Kawasaki 's 636), 675cc 3 cylinder & 750cc 2 cylinder. Slick tyres permitted.
250GP ACU National Championship & NG Cup	250cc Two Stroke GP Prototype machines as per championship conditions
Powerbike	Four-stroke machines 700cc and above. Slick tyres permitted.
Phoenix Open	Solo machines 125cc GP and above (excluding F125 and Juniors). Slick tyres permitted.
Sound of Thunder	Four-stroke single, twin and triple machines. Slick tyres permitted.
MPH Bikes Mini Twins	Solo four-stroke, twin cylinder machines up to 650cc. Refer to Mini Twin regulations
Metzeler DTR 700cc Streetstocks	Solo Machines 401 - 700cc (including up to 750cc twin cylinder four stroke) as per series rules. Metzeler Racetec (including Interact) Control Tyres
Metzeler DTR 1300cc Streetstocks	Solo Machines 701 - 1300cc (excluding up to 750cc twin cylinder four stroke) as per series rules. Metzeler Racetec (including Interact) Control Tyres
Pre Injection – Pre 2001	Solo Machines Manufacture before 2001 and not fuel injected. Championships for 600cc and over 600cc. Slick tyres permitted.
Newcomers	Solo machines in three classes, 1) up to 500cc 2) over 500cc, 3) Minitwins. Entrants must hold a Clubman licence, wear an orange vest and not have held an ACU licence before 1 st January 2011. These classes may only be entered as a second. Slick tyres allowed if licence permits.
CSC Racing Sidecar	For all three-wheeler outfits, separate classes for up to 600cc machines and machines 601cc and above.
