

Covid 19 – August/September 2021

NG Road Racing Guidance and Requirements from August 2021

To be read in addition to the Supplementary Regulations, Final Instructions and Auto Cycle Union Risk Assessment covering Phase 4 of Government/Welsh Assembly easing of lockdown

NG ROAD RACING and circuit owners will continue to enforce face coverings when entering the following buildings at race venues until further notice:

Race Office

Medical Centre/facilities

Paddock Bar/Restaurant (while entering and moving around)

1. Government Guidelines:

- Meeting in well-ventilated areas where possible, such as outdoors or indoors with windows open.
- Wearing a face covering where they come into contact with people they don't normally meet in enclosed and crowded spaces.
- Washing hands with soap and water or using hand sanitiser regularly throughout the day.
- Covering your nose and mouth when you cough and sneeze.
- Staying at home if unwell, to reduce the risk of passing other illnesses onto friends, family, colleagues, and others within the NG ROAD RACING community.
- Considering individual risks, such as clinical vulnerabilities and vaccination

2. Signing on/Race office/Registration:

- The office is not to be used as a social gathering point. No face mask – no entry.
- Results will be presented in the window of offices and you should take a photo from outside the office using your own hand held device. Paper results will not be available.

3. If you have been pinged – and instructed to Self-Isolate by the NHS Test & Trace App, you should not attend the event.

4. If you or any of your team/family develop symptoms of Covid 19 while at the venue, you must all leave the venue immediately. It is important you notify NG Road Racing via phone/text about your situation. The numbers are: Race Office 07580 094577 or Steve Bostock 07967 681639. Do not under any circumstances visit any office at the venue, you must not visit the Medical Centre.

5. Please use the hand sanitise stations positioned at the entrance of each building.
