Pembrey, a track of two halves, Twisty and Technical...but fast.

Pembrey moves from its mid season spot to host the championship finale. Pembrey is the longest standing circuit on the list of NG venues having been a firm favourite since the early 1990's. Racing is always close and the action is right under the spectator's noses, especially at the Esses section. It is fast but features two hard breaking areas at the Hatchets and Brooklands Hairpins. They give great overtaking opportunities... but we are often witness to close calls as riders put strain for the bikes (and their) braking capabilities!!!

With a host of championship titles still to be decided it will be a nervy weekend for many, A slender series lead can still be overturned with 75 points up for grabs over the weekend.

It is also worth mentioning that with the staging of this round NG Road Racing has completed over 50 years of promoting racing in the UK. We have come a long way since the early 70's events on airfield across the West Country.

Directions to the Circuit.

The circuit is situated in Carmarthenshire, South Wales near Llanelli. Approximately 10 miles from J48 of the M4. The chequered flag race circuit brown signs are evident from the motorway. **Sat Nav : SA16 0HZ**

What's on track.

Saturday sees morning warm-up followed by all-important timed qualifying as the riders compete for that coveted pole position, followed by the first round of championship races.

Sunday has warm-up followed by two sets of championship races.

Each championship race sees 25 points going to the winner, right down to 1 point for tenth place.

That's 30 championship finals over the two days of racing to enjoy.
